Table notes

Although the headline ranking figures show annual changes in the data, the pattern of clustering among the schools is equally significant. Some 235 points separate the top programme, Kellogg/HKUST Business School, from the school ranked 100th. The top 14 participants from Kellogg/HKUST to Ceibs form the top group. The second group spans from University of Chicago: Booth at 15 down to the University of St Gallen at 45. The third group is headed by Tongji University/Mannheim Business School down to Baylor University: Hankamer at 89. Finally, the bottom 10 schools headed by Texas A & M University: Mays make up the fourth group.
